

<u>"THE CATHOLIC CHURCH AND THE</u> BLACK LIVES MATTER MOVEMENT"

The Most Reverend Edward K. Braxton, Ph.D., S.T.D., Bishop of Belleville, Illinois, will give a major address on Saturday, Feb. 25 at 2:00 pm at the National Shrine of Our Lady of the Snows, Guild Center, in Belleville on the topic, "The Catholic Church and the Black Lives Matter Movement ". Many Catholics hear the term "black lives matter" and wonder what it means. Does it imply a rejection of people who are not African American? Does it advocate violence and the destruction of property? Is it compatible with the teachings of the Catholic Church? The Bishop's address will answer these and other questions by examining key elements contributing to the racial divide in the United States and the emergence of the Black Lives Matter Movement from the perspective of the Catholic Church. He will explore the reasons why only a small number of African-Americans are Catholics (2.9 million out of nearly 70 million American Catholics), the "all lives matter" vs. "Black lives matter" debate, the negative impact of the erroneous expressions "minorities" and "minority groups," conflicts over issues of morality, and the impact Catholic social doctrine and the Good News of Jesus Christ should have on the racial divide.
