

#### **LITURGY OF THE WORD:**

Leprosy features prominently in the 1<sup>st</sup> Reading and the Gospel. In the 1<sup>st</sup> Reading, the leper is kept outside the community so as to protect everyone else from this communicable disease. But the leper in the Gospel challenges Jesus and Jesus Breaks down the barrier between them, reaches out, touches him and heals him. Consider how we exclude others in our lives, perhaps because we feel they would make us "unclean" and how Jesus would respond. **All of us are called to imitate Jesus.**
