VOCATION CORNER:

Fr. Pat York is the Dean of Students & Vice-Rector at Conception Seminary College. Fr. Pat recalls he considered the priesthood during his 8th grade year. He credits his parents as having the biggest influence on his priestly vocation. They encouraged their children to be open to God's call as a priest or religious in the Church. The seed of his vocation took root in his family and grew from there. He would ask his parishioners, "*Pray for the priests of our diocese*. *Support your parish priests. Pray fervently to the Lord for more religious vocations.*" Fr. Pat also encourages parents to set an example for their children in practicing their faith, "do not treat it as a *burden or obligation, but as a gift that is enriching.*" (*The Tower Topics, by Fr.
