

ST. DAMIAN LADIES SODALITY & QUILT COMMITTEE:

- ⇒ *Quilt/Cash Donation Guideline* has been developed for St. Damian Parish. This came as a request from several who were new to the parish or for some who had questions about various donations. Quilt or cash donations are needed for fundraisers throughout the year. The fundraisers include quilt raffles, a quilt bingo at the church picnic, and a picnic ticket raffle. If at all possible, please consider giving a quilt or the cash equivalent of the cost of a quilt which runs from \$225.00-\$275.00, if possible. The quilt committee purchases quilts from the cash donations. Please remember the quilts should measure 90" X 106". Quilts must be handquilted or custom machine quilted (quilting must follow the lines/markings on the quilt top, no overall stitch design throughout the quilt). Basic/standard machine quilts should not be donated. Families are asked to donate what they are able. This could range from one quilt/cash per family to no more than 2 families sharing a quilt donation.
- ⇒ Quilt/Cash Sign-up Sheets for the picnic is posted at both entrances of the church. Please mark if you intend to donate cash or a quilt ASAP so we know how many quilts need to be purchased.
- ⇒ 'Que & Brew' Raffle held in October. A picture of the Cardinal quilt for the raffle is in the envelope along with the donation guideline and tickets. Please pick up your envelope in the back of church.
