Today's scriptures each tell the story of the Resurrection from a different perspective. Saint Peter in the 1st Reading tells us how the Resurrection inspired the early Church, and St. Paul off his recommendations for how to respond to the Resurrection in our own lives. Our Gospel simply relates the story of the empty tomb and leaves each of us with a question to ponder: "What does it mean to you that Christ is risen from the dead?"


