




Today, May 7th, is World Day of Prayer for Vocations. The purpose of the World Day of Prayer *for Vocations* is to publically fulfill the Lord's instruction to, "Pray the Lord of the harvest to send laborers into His harvest" (Mt 9:38; Lk 10:2). As a climax to a prayer that is continually offered throughout the Church, it affirms the primacy of faith and grace in all that concerns vocations to the priesthood and to the consecrated life.
