VOCATION CORNER:

Pentecost!! What a celebration! The Lord sends us the Holy Spirit to guide us on our way after redeeming us from our sins. The Apostles were filled with the Holy Spirit and began speaking in many tongues so everyone understood in contrast to the story of the Tower of Babel. May we be blessed with the right words as we talk with our youth about the possibility of choosing a religious vocation – priest, sister or a brother. May we also be filled with the Spirit to live out our own vocation in the best way possible.

CHURCH REOPENING AMID COVID-19:

As you may have heard, Bishop Braxton, together with Cardinal Cupich and the Bishops of Illinois recently shared their multi-phased plan for reopening churches in the six dioceses of Illinois. Specifically, Phase I allows for parishes to open for Baptism, Reconciliation, Weddings and Funerals with a limit of 10 attendees (excluding ministers). Phase IA allows for parishes to reopen for private prayer and adoration with a limit of 10 attendees (excluding ministers). Phase II allows for reopening for weekday and weekend Masses for larger groups depending on the guidelines from the state and the capacity of the church building. We do not have a timetable for Phase II, but no weekday or weekend Masses with a congregation of any size are allowed until we reach this phase.

First and foremost, it is important for everyone to understand that our efforts will prioritize the safety and wellbeing of all while maintaining due respect and reverence for the sacraments and liturgical norms of our faith.

Together we will attend required training to ensure that our parish reopening plan conforms to the guidelines developed by the diocese in collaboration with civil and healthcare authorities.

We will need volunteers to assist with various aspects of our parish reopening plan. Importantly, leadership team members and volunteers should not be a part of a "vulnerable population" (that is, not over the age of 65; no underlying medical conditions such as diabetes; lung disease; ongoing cancer treatment, etc), if possible. We are asking all who are younger than 65 and healthy with no underlying health conditions to consider assisting with one of three reopening teams: **Set-up Team, Greeting Team, and Cleaning Team.** From those that step forward, we will also request that some act as volunteer captains to help lead each of the three teams.

The guidelines and measures required to reopen are designed to protect our wellbeing and that of our broader community. Our collective patience, willingness to help and the care we take to reopen is a demonstration of our unity and love for one another. More information will be available as we proceed. The entire letter is posted on the front page of the website.
