### **LITURGY OF THE WORD**:

Today's Readings: *Exodus 34:4b-6, 8-9; 2 Corinthians 13:11-13; John 3:16-18.* **Don't let your mind wander!** Each Reading is very short, so if your mind is wandering, you may miss the point. You wouldn't want to do that, for in each case a lot is packed into just a few verses. God reveals the holy name in the 1<sup>st</sup> Reading. Paul sums up his message to the Corinthians in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading. In the Gospel, John synthesizes Jesus' entire mission in three short verses. Let us envision the Readings as if each author is speaking directly to us.

## CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION:

A Corpus Christi procession will take place **next weekend, June 13<sup>th</sup>/14<sup>th</sup>** after the Saturday and Sunday Masses. Saturday around St. Bernard and Sunday around St. Damian. The route will be published on our Facebook pages and website in the upcoming days. All of this is weather permitting. Also, subject to adjustments/change based on the status of our public Masses.

#### What is a Corpus Christi procession?

"The Corpus Christi procession, most often held on the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, is a "public witness of faith and worship of the Most Blessed Sacrament."

A Corpus Christi procession usually begins after the celebration of Mass, at which the host for the procession is consecrated. Placed in a monstrance (a sacred vessel that displays the sacred host to the faithful), the Blessed Sacrament is then carried out of the church and through the streets of the city or neighborhood." In this way the Church shows that Christ, here among us, walks with us on our pilgrimage to heaven.

### **GUIDELINES FOR ATTENDING CHURCH:**

Bishop Braxton, along with the Illinois bishops and the governor have stated that we can reopen our churches for public Masses. The first scheduled Masses are **next weekend**, **June 13<sup>th</sup>/14<sup>th</sup>**. Of course, things will be different since there is a limit of 50 people at this time.

**Before you arrive:** Check your temperature and if you have one, please do not come to church. Stay at home if you feel ill. Make sure you have a face covering to bring and wear. Remember to sign-up to ensure we do not go over the limit. Sign up on the website at <u>www.stbernardandstdamian.org</u> under the Mass you wish to attend. If you do not use a computer, please call/text Deacon Glenn Netemeyer at 618-772-9343 by Friday.

When you arrive: Enter only in marked doorways. Wait patiently to be checked in by a greeter/usher. Keep you face covering or mask on at all times except for receiving Communion. Sanitize your hands as directed by greeter/usher. Observe social distancing at all times (6 feet apart). Greeters/Ushers will direct you to pews on where to sit.

**During the Mass:** Do not change seats. No physical sign of peace will be exchanged during Mass. Follow instructions for Communion:

- 1. Leave your seat only when directed by greeter/usher.
- 2. Maintain social distancing in the Communion line.
- 3. Approach the Communion Minster only after you are called forward. Do not remove you face covering. Extend a single hand to receive the host.
- 4. After moving 6 feet to the right or left, remove your mask and consume the host. Then replace you face covering or mask.

After the Mass: Please take anything you have brought with you. Take the wipes (available in the pews) and wipe down your area. You will be dismissed by pew or seating area, following the instructions of the greeter/usher. Use only the designated exit doors. Do not congregate outside the church doors. Continue to wear your face covering or mask until you leave the area.

**Parking Communion:** If you are uncomfortable in entering the church, the Mass can be watched from your phone in the parking lot. Communion will be available at the main entrance outside of church. Please remember to social distance.
