FAITH FORMATION REGISTRATION:

Registration forms will be emailed and are also available on the website under 'Faith Education', click 'Faith Formation' then under your parish name. Please contact the parish office if you need any assistance.

- > Students already in the Faith Formation program: parents/guardians & students are asked to read the policy handbook (on the website) and sign the *Commitment Form*. Parents/guardians and students must sign the form, also be sure to give the grade the student is entering. Signing the commitment form will ensure that your child/children is/are enrolled in Faith Formation for 2020-2021 (one form per family).

GUIDELINES FOR ATTENDING CHURCH:

Churches are now opened for public Masses. Of course, things will be different since there is a limit of 50 people at this time.

Before you arrive: Check your temperature and if you have one, please do not come to church. Stay at home if you feel ill. Make sure you have a face covering to bring and wear. Remember to sign-up to ensure we do not go over the limit. Sign up on the website at www.stbernardandstdamian.org under the Mass you wish to attend. If you do not use a computer, please call/text Deacon Glenn Netemeyer at 618-772-9343 by Friday.

When you arrive: Enter only in marked doorways. Wait patiently to be checked in by a greeter/usher. Keep you face covering or mask on at all times except for receiving Communion. Sanitize your hands as directed by greeter/usher. Observe social distancing at all times (6 feet apart). Greeters/Ushers will direct you to pews where to sit.

<u>During the Mass</u>: Do not change seats. No physical sign of peace will be exchanged during Mass. Follow instructions for Communion:

- 1. Leave your seat only when directed by greeter/usher.
- 2. Maintain social distancing in the Communion line.
- 3. Approach the Communion Minster only after you are called forward. Do not remove you face covering. Extend a single hand to receive the host.
- 4. After moving 6 feet to the right or left, remove your mask and consume the host. Then replace you face covering or mask.

After the Mass: Please take anything you have brought with you. Take the wipes (available in the pews) and wipe down your area. You will be dismissed by pew or seating area, following the instructions of the greeter/usher. Use only the designated exit doors. Do not congregate outside the church doors. Continue to wear your face covering or mask until you leave the area.

<u>Parking Communion</u>: If you are uncomfortable in entering the church, the Mass can be watched from your phone in the parking lot. Communion will be available at the main entrance outside of church. Please remember to social distance.
