ORDINATION PROFILE:

This week, the Diocese of Belleville receives its 9th Bishop – Fr. Michael McGovern – being installed on **Wednesday, July 22nd.** We heartily pray that God give him the graces needed to lead our Diocese. Per the Diocesan announcement: "He is the youngest of 8 children in a devoutly Catholic family. A graduate of St. Ignatius College Prep, Loyola University and St. Mary of the Lake Seminary, he was ordained to the priesthood of Jesus Christ by Joseph Cardinal Bernardin, Archbishop of Chicago, on May 21, 1994. Father McGovern has said he is a Chicago White Sox fan and enjoys Italian art and English literature. Bishop-Elect McGovern succeeds The Most Reverend Edward K. Braxton, Ph.D., S.T.D., who on his seventy-fifth birthday, June 28, 2019, wrote to the Holy Father the canonically required letter of resignation. Bishop Braxton was installed as the Eighth Bishop of Belleville on the Feast of St. Thomas More, June 22, 2005.

GUIDELINES FOR ATTENDING CHURCH:

Churches are now opened for public Masses. Of course, things will be different since there is a limit of 50 people at this time.

Before you arrive: Check your temperature and if you have one, please do not come to church. Stay at home if you feel ill. Make sure you have a face covering to bring and wear. Remember to sign-up to ensure we do not go over the limit. Sign up on the website at www.stbernardandstdamian.org under the Mass you wish to attend. If you do not use a computer, please call/text Deacon Glenn Netemeyer at 618-772-9343 by Friday.

<u>When you arrive</u>: Enter only in marked doorways. Wait patiently to be checked in by a greeter/usher. Keep you face covering or mask on at all times except for receiving Communion. Sanitize your hands as directed by greeter/usher. Observe social distancing at all times (6 feet apart). Greeters/Ushers will direct you to pews where to sit.

<u>During the Mass</u>: Do not change seats. No physical sign of peace will be exchanged during Mass. Follow instructions for Communion:

- 1. Leave your seat only when directed by greeter/usher.
- 2. Maintain social distancing in the Communion line.
- 3. Approach the Communion Minster only after you are called forward. Do not remove your face covering. Extend a single hand to receive the host.
- 4. After moving 6 feet to the right or left, remove your mask and consume the host. Then replace your face covering or mask.

<u>After the Mass</u>: Please take anything you have brought with you. You will be dismissed by pew or seating area, following the instructions of the greeter/usher. Use only the designated exit doors. Do not congregate outside the church doors. Continue to wear your face covering or mask until you leave the area.

<u>Parking Communion</u>: If you are uncomfortable in entering the church, the Mass can be watched from your phone in the parking lot. Communion will be available at the main entrance outside of church. Please remember to social distance.
