

Our readings today reveal and confirm God's desire to shepherd us: to care for, protect, and comfort us as shepherds tend their sheep. In the 1st Reading, God promises to provide shepherds for the people, particularly a descendant of David who will rule wisely and justly. In the Gospel, Jesus, Son of David, is moved with pity when people flock to him, comparing them to sheep without a shepherd. With these passages in mind, we are able to sing in the psalm, "The Lord is my Shepherd, there is nothing I shall want."
