

LITURGY OF THE WORD:

Today's readings counsel us not to focus on things of the world. The 1st Reading calls all such things "vanities". In the 2nd Reading, Saint Paul tells us to think of what is above, for Christ is all in all. The Gospel message about possessions isn't new, but it has special meaning for us in our consumer society. Jesus urges us to be rich in "what matters to God". Let us try to hear what God is telling us about what really matters. We are challenged to discern whether we have taken off our old selves and put on our new selves in Christ.

"If today you hear His voice, harden not your hearts."


