

LITURGY OF THE WORD:

Today's readings focus on humility and helping those in need. The 1st reading's message about humility sets the stage for the Gospel reading. The Gospel is not about our dinner parties; it is a metaphor for how we interact with others in our lives. These readings seem especially relevant now. **How do we conduct ourselves in a culture that promotes success, power, self-aggrandizement at every level?** Awareness – both of self and others – is essential. Jesus calls us to look beyond ourselves to others and expect no reward in return. That sounds easier than it is, which is why we're still talking about it. Let us listen for the message that we need to hear about whom we welcome into the banquet of our own lives.


