The way to follow this model is to love one another, as Paul exhorts us to do in the 2nd Reading. Yet listen for Jesus' advice for how to deal with someone who is uncompromising: *"treat them as you would a Gentile or a tax collector"*. How did Jesus treat them? What does that mean for you? If we love and respect one another, the steps to healing are made possible.

- ⇒ The Second Collection taken this weekend, September 9th/10th, will go to support the relief efforts of *Hurricane Harvey in Texas and Louisiana*. The funds collected in this one-time special appeal will be used to support the efforts of *Catholic Charities USA*, the official domestic relief agency of the U.S. Catholic Church. They respond to immediate emergency needs for necessities such as water, food, shelter, and medical care as well as to the long term needs to rebuild and recover after widespread destruction, and of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops for pastoral and reconstruction aid to the Church.
- ⇒ Our Belleville Diocese currently has 55 diocesan priests of retirement age 35 who are currently retired and 20 who remain in active ministry; in five years that number will increase to 64!
