

YOUR HELP IS NEEDED! PUT YOUR OLD, UNWANTED SHOES TO GOOD USE!

The following service project is being performed by the Confirmation class and their parents. Trisha Rolves, former member of St. Bernard Church, has a 4 year old son who has autism. He likes to leave the house (he is evidently very good at "escaping") and wanders, which is obviously very unsafe for him and frightening for his family. They are in the process of raising money to purchase a service dog to be his constant companion and help keep him safe at home. The dog will cost \$15,000. One of the fundraisers they are doing is a *shoe drive*. Old shoes (wearable or not) are collected. They will receive 40 cents for every pound of shoes. The usable shoes will be shipped to places (domestic and abroad) where people need shoes. The shoes can be children or adults, flip flops or any kind of shoes, wearable or too beat up for any use, but there must be a pair. A box will be available in the back of church for you to deposit your shoes. Please tie the pair together, rubber band them together or put each pair in a separate plastic bag to make sure the pairs stay together. Trisha's family will be home for Christmas and will rent a U-Haul to ship the shoes to their destination. The shoe drive will run **until Sunday, December 12**th.
