

#### YOUR HELP IS NEEDED! PUT YOUR OLD, UNWANTED SHOES TO GOOD USE!

The following Confirmation service project is being performed by the following students and their parents: *Hunter Jansen* (Matthew/Diana), *Chris Kalmer* (Steve/Barb), *Mason Schrage* (Butch/Tammy). Trisha Rolves, former member of St. Bernard Church, has a 4 year old son who has autism. They are in the process of raising money to purchase a service dog, which cost \$15,000, to be his constant companion and help keep him safe at home. One of the fundraisers they are doing is a *shoe drive*. Old shoes (wearable or not) are being collected and will be shipped to places (domestic and abroad) where people need shoes. They will receive 40 cents for every pound of shoes. The shoes can be children or adults, flip flops or any kind of shoes, wearable or too beat up for any use, but there must be a pair. A box will be available in the back of both churches for you to deposit your shoes or at the students' homes. Please tie the pair together, rubber band them together or put each pair in a separate plastic bag to make sure the pairs stay together.
