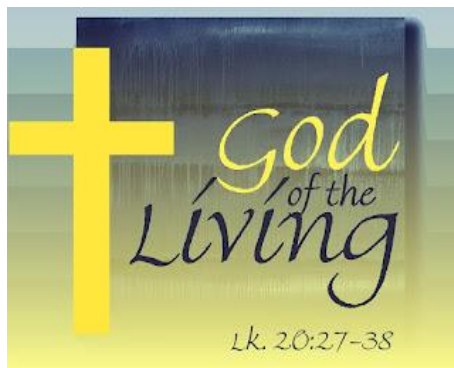

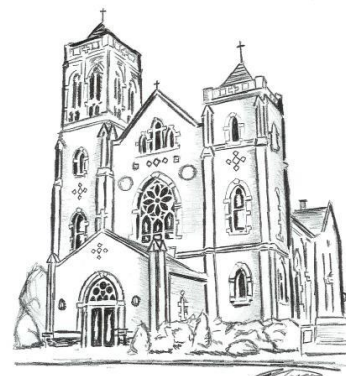

**2 Maccabees 7: 1-2, 9-14; 2 Thessalonians 2:16-3:5; Luke 20: 27-38**

The selections from scripture that we hear today portray people whose faith in eternal life with the Lord gives them confidence during times of trial. 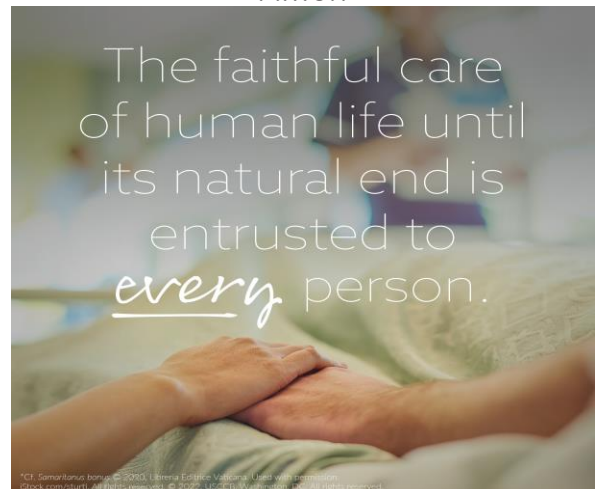
