## **LITURGY OF THE WORD:**

#### <u>1 Samuel 16: 1b, 6–7, 10-13a; Ephesians 5:8–14; John 9:1–41</u>

Today's readings explore the theme of blindness, both literal and metaphorical. The man born literally blind receives his eyesight by Jesus' action in the Gospel, but we also witness Samuel's metaphorical blindness to David's fitness for kingship, the Pharisees' blindness to Jesus' holiness, and even the willful blindness of the blind man's parents when they are questioned. May God's word help us examine our own blindness as we welcome the light of Christ.
