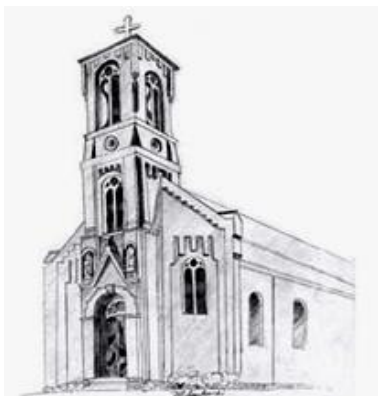
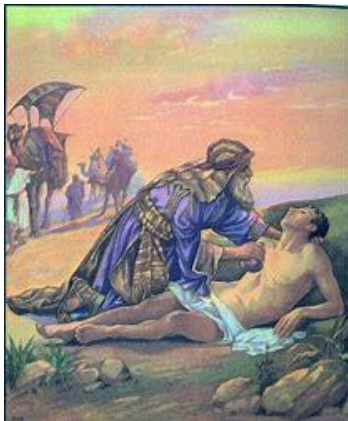

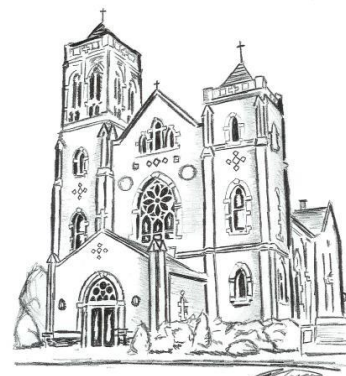

LITURGY OF THE WORD:

Deuteronomy 30: 10-14; Colossians 1: 15-20; Luke 10: 25-37

Moses speaks to a sinful people in the first reading, pleading with them to keep the LORD's commandments as they repent with their whole heart and soul. In the Gospel, a scholar of the law-of all God's commandments-goes one step further, asking Jesus what he must do to inherit eternal life. Realizing that loving one's neighbor is at the heart of the answer, he asks Jesus who his neighbor is. It is in this context that Jesus tells the parable of the Good Samaritan, asking the questioner who was the true neighbor. May today's readings inspire us to accept the challenge to treat all others-friends or strangers-as worthy of our love.
