LITURGY OF THE WORD:

Amos 8:4-7; 1 Timothy 2:1-8; Luke 16: 1-13

Our readings today challenge how we regard wealth and poverty. First, we hear the prophet Amos strongly condemn those who build wealth by cheating the poor. The psalmist declares that the Lord rescues those who are poor. Saint Paul reminds us of the wealth we have in the Lord.
