

Respect Life Corner- In Luke's Gospel, Simeon while near death, anxiously awaits his chance to meet the Christ Child in the presentation of the Lord in the Temple. He amazes Mary and Joseph in the temple, with his enthusiasm and words proclaiming Jesus as the salvation of Israel. He holds Jesus in his arms and gives thanks to God that he has seen His salvation. Simeon, the prophet and Anna, the prophetess, provide a voice to the shepherds visiting the manger in humble homage. Jesus's arrival is heralded as the savior who calls men and women for God's Kingdom more than two thousand years ago and today. Learn, Act, Connect and Pray-Mary and Joseph were rich in love for each other and their son, Jesus, bur poor in material goods. The couple offered two pigeons in the temple, instead of a lamb, as they dedicated the Christ Child. Many women want to be good mothers in our community, but lack resources. How can we take the good news of Christ's arrival to those who have very little? Donating gently used maternity clothing, toddler clothing, diapers, formula to a pregnancy care center near you is a good way to start thinking of those in need. Consider praying at The Fence of Planned Parenthood and offering words of hope and encouragement to those searching for answers.
