The Knights of Columbus was founded March 29<sup>th</sup>, 1882. It was formed by Father Michael J. McGivney to unite men of Catholic faith. Today, the Knights are centered on the 4 principles of Charity, Unity, Fraternity and Patriotism. The primary principle of the Knights of Columbus has always been charity. In that spirit, each year the Albers/Damiansville council awards \$500 in tuition assistance to one 8<sup>th</sup> grade student from Albers and one 8<sup>th</sup> grade student from Damiansville as they continue their education at a Catholic High School.
