- 6. **MINUTES FROM THE AUGUST 8, 2017 MEETING:** The minutes from the previous meeting were approved by council members via email and published to the congregation.
- 7. **PARISH LIFE:** There was a discussion held regarding the change in Sat. evening mass time. This previous weekend Fr. - **9. BUILDING & MAINTENANCE:** Al Varel reported the soffit and facial on the rectory and garage is now complete. The council agreed to replacing the garage man door of the rectory which Al offered to install, he was given a quote of 240.00 from Gary Santel. Al is checking into repair of the porch columns of the rectory that are rusting through. Light bulbs have been purchased but not yet installed for the church, (hoping this will address the flickering issue). Al also informed the council that the flag pole at the cemetery needed to be replaced.
- **10. HOLY NAME AND ALTAR SODALITY:** The euchre tournament (hosted by the Altar Sodality) was down from previous years but they also did not have a quilt raffle 906.00 was the total profit.
- 11. OLD BUSINESS: The old sound sys. was sold for 42.00.

Jerry Toennies (President of the Holy Name) addressed the ongoing discussion of the cemetery trees. He informed the council that some of the parishioners feel the trees were put there for a reason, stating cedar trees can be symbolic of eternal life. The concern of the weak branches and the harm it can do to the old tombstones, (not to mention the underground destruction that might be problematic as well) is still a maintenance concern. It was decided to table the issue and possibly address it at the Holy Name meeting to get further input/discussion.

**12. NEW BUSINESS**: The school shared the new Gym Rental Agreement with the council and there were a few things that needed clarification i.e. if the church organizations also get free rental and if EVERYONE pays a deposit?
